A big bottle of Franck Thomas' Brut NV, our flagship Champagne here at SVS. Perfect pre-dinner drinking when you are entertaining a crowd – or when serving a seafood first course, allowing the aperitif to follow you to the table. Jeroboams available too – ask for details. 12%. Now-2030

Château de la Liquière, Faugères Blanc, Cuvée Cistus, France, 2023

A serious Roussillon white made from Roussanne with Grenache Blanc and Rolle with a small proportion aged in barriques. Fourrey, Chablis, 1er Cru Côte de Lechet, France, 2023

2023 was a warm year in Burgundy and the whites are delicious, forward and – in many cases like this – ready to drink now. Packed with the concentration one expects from a 1er Cru site this has overt apple fruit with a little blossom too. 13.5%. Now-2032

Château Beausejour, Fronsac, France, 2020

Magnum: £33.00 **6% off 3:** £93.06 **12% off 6:** £174.24

95% Merlot, and 5% Cabernet Franc in this vintage. Wonderful ripeness and aromatics. Fleshy blackcurrant flavours with light tannins. Excellent persistence and a pleasing plumminess rounds it out. A high quality, classically-styled red Bordeaux. 14%. Now-2027



Château Barrejat, Madiran Vieux Ceps, France, 2022

Magnum: £38.95 **6% off 3:** £109.84 **12% off 6:** £205.66

Fantastic old vine bottling made from 80% Tannat with Cabernets Sauvignon and Franc. Rich and well-oaked it has flamboyant flavours of cherry, plum and blueberry, all tinged with mocha. Absolutely delicious from magnum. 14.5%. Now-2031

Domaine Lagneau, Morgon Vieilles Vignes, France, 2023

Magnum: £39.95 **6% off 3:** £112.66 **12% off 6:** £210.94

A top-tier cru Beaujolais from a super grower who has a wealth of very old vines. Concentrated and deep with focused, pure blackberry and plum fruit with subtle floral notes, silky tannins and a beautifully fresh finish. 13.5%. Now-2032

Château Bellegrave, Pauillac, France, 2020

 **Code:** BLL920

Magnum: £75.00 **6% off 3:** £211.50 **12% off 6:** £396.00

Bellegrave lies in an enviable spot between the Pichons and Lynch-Bages and offers terrific value compared to those illustrious neighbours. Lots of, juicy cassis fruit, well-judged oak with ripe, rounded tannins. 15%. Now-2032



Boasso, Barolo, Serralunga, Italy, 2020

 **Code:** BOA920

Magnum: £76.50 **6% off 3:** £215.73 **12% off 6:** £403.92

Intense aromas of red fruit with a singed edge. Fleshy and ripe, all melting strawberries and subtle rose petals. Gentle structure - so ready for drinking already, though plenty of potential for keeping too. 14.5%. Now-2031



Huber-Verdereau, Monthélie, La Combe Danay, France, 2023

 **Code:** HUB623M

Magnum: £88.00 **6% off 3:** £248.16 **12% off 6:** £464.64

Monthélie is nestled between Volnay and Meursault and produces some of the prettiest of Côte de Beaune reds. This comes from a cooler, late-ripening plot which did exceptionally well in the warmer 2023 vintage. Balanced and long, with a vibrant note of wild strawberries. 13%. Now-2029



Château Meyney, Saint-Estephe, France, 2016

Magnum: £105.00 **6% off 3:** £296.10 **12% off 6:** £554.40

A top red Bordeaux drinking very well now. *"Tasted blind. Very dark crimson. Intense Indian ink on the nose. Give me my calligraphy pen! Rich and round. Very glamorous. So much effort has gone into every drop of this VGV 18.5/20"*, Jancis Robinson MW, [jancisrobinson.com](https://www.jancisrobinson.com), January 2024. 14%. Now-2050

Château Barrejat, Madiran Tradition, France, 2022 (5 Litre)

 **Code:** BAJ522

5Lt Jeroboam: £105.00

"Lively blackish crimson. Firm, rich, some but not excessive tannin. Very sappy and refreshing. Arguably more interesting than a red bordeaux at this excellent price. Juicy but structured. Should last well. In fact, if you ever needed a snip of a Jeroboam (5-litre bottle) for a celebration in 2028, go for this! Long. Champagne

It wouldn't be Christmas without Champagne and these are our top picks for this year. As always, our 'house' grower Champagne from Thomas-Hatté leads the way. It is stunning value for money and absolutely the real deal – unlike many of the made up brands that pop up in the big supermarkets every December. If you want to splash out on a Grande Marque, then our tip goes to Pol Roger – we sell lots of this in our Stockbridge shop which helps us keep the price very competitive.

Thomas-Hatté, Brut Champagne, France, NV

Bottle: £29.50 **6% off 6:** £166.38 **12% off 12:** £311.52

70% Pinot Meunier, 20% Chardonnay and 10% Pinot Noir which gives a full-flavoured style that we adore. *"Really biscuity nose and then great freshness and balance with a very well-judged dosage. Not for the long haul but one of the best-value champagnes I have encountered recently. 16.5/20, Drink 2024-2027"* Jancis Robinson MW, [jancisrobinson.com](https://www.jancisrobinson.com), October 2024. 12%. Thomas-Hatté, Vintage Champagne, Brut, France, 2020

Code: HAT620
Bottle: £34.95 **6% off 6:** £197.12 **12% off 12:** £369.07

Thomas-Hatté's vintage cuvée sees Chardonnay take the leading role with 50% of the blend, followed by 30% Pinot Noir and 20% Pinot Meunier. This assemblage gives the wine an added freshness and zip compared to the Brut whilst maintaining the toasty, brioche-like notes that characterise all Thomas-Hatté Champagnes. A definite step up from the NV – and more age-worthy too. Superb value at just over a fiver more per bottle than the NV. 12%. Now-2030

Pol Roger, Champagne Brut Reserve, France, NV

Bottle: £49.00 **6% off 6:** £276.36 **12% off 12:** £517.44

SVS's favourite Grandes Marque Champagne. It is always elegant and refined, a result of the slow fermentation in the deep cellars some 33m beneath Épernay and then at least three years' ageing in bottle. It ages well too. 12.5%. Now-2029

Louis Roederer, Champagne, Collection 245, France, NV

Code: ROE145
Bottle: £49.50 **6% off 6:** £279.18 **12% off 12:** £522.72

41% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir, 24% Pinot Meunier. This latest NV release from Roederer is based on the 2020 vintage (55%) with reserve wines stretching back to 2012 added to the assemblage. Full-flavoured style with notes of brioche, toasted almonds and nectarine with a delicious saline, oyster shell edge to the finish. 12.5%. Now-2028

Billecart-Salmon, Champagne, Rosé, France, NV

Code: BISNV5
Bottle: £69.95 **6% off 6:** £394.52 **12% off 12:** £738.67

"Billy Rosé" as it is affectionally known in the trade is still the standard bearer for pink Champagne. 40% reserve wines add vinous depth and complexity to the bright citrus and redcurrant fruit. Stylish bottle, very stylish wine too. 12%. Now-2027



Sparkling Wines

Fizz from France, Italy and South Africa here, including two excellent pink sparklers. Of the two Crémants from France – the Diamant is a perfect party sparkler while the Clotilde Davenne is much tastier than many more expensive Champagnes.

Diamant, Crémant de Loire, France, NV

Code: DIA1NV
Bottle: £14.25 **6% off 6:** £80.37 **12% off 12:** £150.48

The Loire has been our go-to region for best value French fizz for a long time. The relatively northern climate allied to Chenin Blanc's suitability for bubbles is a winning combination. This is a blend of Chenin and Chardonnay from near Saumur. Ripe, gently apple fruit, lightly creamy, with a little structure too. 12.5%. Now-2026.

Drusian, Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore, Extra Dry, Italy, NV

Prosecco has been given something of a bad reputation as a result of the mass produced, inexpensive but inarticulate wines that dominate supermarket shelves. This is a very different beast. Slowly fermented from 100% Glera grapes this is sherberty and light with the merest hint of fruity ripeness. 11%. Now-2026

Tenuta di Cart, Rose Mari, Vino Spumante Rosato, Pinot Nero, Italy, NV

Code: CAR5NV
Bottle: £17.50 **6% off 6:** £98.70 **12% off 12:** £184.80

This pink sparkler is not a Rosato Prosecco: Prosecco is made from the Glera grape - this is far superior, being 100% Pinot Nero (Pinot Noir). Made in the same way as Prosecco (i.e. in a closed tank), this is a gently fizzy, very pale pink glass of red fruit - wild strawberries tinged with pear. Fine mousse. Very lightly savoury, this makes a perfect aperitif, and a bottle vanishes very quickly indeed. 12%. Now-2026



Domaine des Dieux, Rose of Sharon, MCC Brut, South Africa, 2016

Code: DDD216
Bottle: £19.95 **6% off 6:** £112.52 **12% off 12:** £210.67

Megan Mullis is the queen of Méthode Cap Classique (MCC), South Africa's name for Champagne method sparklers. I must have tasted two dozen MCC wines in Cape Town in September and very few could match this for quality. The palest of pale pinks in colour, the nine years bottle ageing gives a ripe, brioche note to frame the subtle red berry fruit. Terrific value too. 12%. Now-2026

Clotilde Davenne, Crémant de Bourgogne, France, NV

Code: CLO1NV
Bottle: £20.95 **6% off 6:** £118.16 **12% off 12:** £221.23

A superb zéro dosage Crémant: 60% from Chardonnay, 40% from Pinot Noir (planted in 1973), both off Kimmeridgian soils west of Chablis; and based on the 2019 vintage. Classic, super-clean example, wholly dry, crisp and lightly chalky. This makes a deliciously refreshing aperitif – or would be brilliant with seared scallops. 12.5%. Now-2026

Les Chapelières, Comté Tolosan IGP, France, 2024

Code: AGW324

An easy drinking blend from south-west France of 70% fruity Colombard and 30% crisp Ugni Blanc, with lowish alcohol and refreshing bite. Clean and lemony, ripe and grassy, with a juicy freshness. 11%. Now-2026

Goedverwacht, Great Expectations, Chenin Blanc, South Africa, 2025

Code: GDV725
Bottle: £10.95 6% off 6: £61.76 12% off 12: £115.63

2025 is a superb vintage in the Cape and this is a forward, zesty Chenin Blanc with notes of white peach and green apple. No oak - just refreshing, bright fruit all the way through. Very good on its own or with lighter pasta and seafood dishes. 12.5%. Now-2027

Amoruccio, Grillo, Italy, 2024

Code: AMO124
Bottle: £11.25 6% off 6: £63.45 12% off 12: £118.80

Widely planted in Sicily, the Grillo grape has the advantage of retaining freshness, lowish alcohol and character in the Mediterranean heat. Well-textured, lemony freshness and decent follow through. Excellent typicity to this increasingly popular grape. 13%. Now-2026



La Combe Saint-Paul, Rolle, IGP Pays d'Oc, France, 2024

Code: CSP224
Bottle: £11.50 6% off 6: £64.86 12% off 12: £121.44

One of our best-selling whites. Rolle (the grape formerly known as Vermentino) thrives on Paul Maury's estate near La Clape. Bone-dry but zingy with generous stone fruit. Lots of wine for the money. 12.5%. Now-2026

Domaine des Forges, Sauvignon Blanc, France, 2024

Code: FOR724
Bottle: £11.75 6% off 6: £66.27 12% off 12: £124.08

There's much to praise here: an accessible, fruity, Loire Sauvignon Blanc that comes in at just 11% this year. Crisp, grassy, green apple fruit to the fore. Enjoyable with or without food. Now-2026



Party & Everyday Reds

Sur, Carmenère, Chile, 2023

Code: SUR123
Bottle: £9.50 6% off 6: £53.58 12% off 12: £100.32

A smart Carmenère from Chile with a classic combination of blackcurrant fruit with herbal elements. The aromas show that characteristic combination of berries with currant leaf. This offers a light and fresh mouthful of blackcurrant and blueberry. Pure, uncomplicated and finishes brightly. Great on its own, it is versatile with food too and is very happy matching up with spice. 13%. Now-2026

Bajel Pirata, Monastrell, Spain, 2024

Code: PIR124
Bottle: £9.50 6% off 6: £53.58 12% off 12: £100.32

Simon's choice of what to drink at home: *"Everyone needs a red you can marinade with, cook with and drink at the same time: this black-fruited, juicy and lightly savoury red hits the spot. Monastrell (= Mourvèdre) is Spain's under-rated grape"*. 13%. Now-2026

Les Pradelles, IGP Hérault, France, 2023

Code: PRD123
Bottle: £9.75 6% off 6: £54.99 12% off 12: £102.96

Bottled at a smart new co-op at Cébazan in Saint-Chinian, this is an easy-drinking blend of Carignan and Grenache from the plains of the Languedoc. Red fruited with a surprisingly good texture, no rough edges, soft, light and juicily berried. Perfect for uncomplicated daily drinking. 12.5%. Now-2026



Comtesse de Marion, Merlot, IGP d'Oc, France, 2023

Code: VIC323
Bottle: £11.95 6% off 6: £67.40 12% off 12: £126.19

Attractive archetypal Merlot: aromas of sweet plum with a leafy touch, followed by a supple and lightly creamy, berried palate with barely discernible tannins. Very popular. 13.5%. Now-2026

Six Hats, Pinotage, South Africa, 2023

Code: SIX623
Bottle: £12.95 6% off 6: £73.04 12% off 12: £136.75

Ripe, juicy Victoria plum and blackberry fruit with hints of hoisin sauce, damsons and a twist of black pepper. Medium-bodied and very easy drinking. 14%. Now-2026.



Christmas Cracker Whites

It may be the bleak midwinter outside but lots of festive food demands a glass of cool white wine. Smoked salmon (or even better smoked trout) and oysters are the obvious matches but think spicy food too: Albariño and Thai fish cakes is a winning combination all year round.

L'Oratge, Garnatxa Blanca, Terra Alta, Spain, 2024 🍷

Code: CDE724
Bottle: £13.25 6% off 6: £74.73 12% off 12: £139.92

A new livery this vintage for the wine formerly known as Las Colinas del Ebro. The name and label may have changed but everything else is much as it was: a super value, dry-but-fruity white from the Catalan mountains inland from Barcelona. Grapefruit scented with herbs - rosemary and bay leaf - with attractive pithiness and an incisive, lightly almondy finish. 13%. Now-2027

Le Tende, Custoza, Italy, 2024 🍷

Code: LET124
Bottle: £14.95 6% off 6: £84.32 12% off 12: £157.87

Despite having its DOC since 1971, Custoza has long been in the shadow of wines such as Soave and Gavi, but deserves much better recognition - especially when made this well. A blend of Garganega, Tocai (= Trebbianello) and Cortese, this is fresh, zesty and full of citrus fruit with some mineral notes too. Perfect with seafood, lighter pastas and salads. 12.5%. Now-2026

Aba de Trasmúia, Albariño, Rias Baixas, Spain, 2024

Code: TRA124
Bottle: £15.95 6% off 6: £89.96 12% off 12: £168.43

From the tiny Moraima co-operative (just 11 partners and only 11 hectares of vineyards), and part sourced from ancient trellised vines, this is as refreshing as the Atlantic Ocean which laps the Rias Baixas. Ripe lemon and bright apricot come together brilliantly, with a fine vein of acidity. With the merest hint of salinity, this is open and easy to enjoy on any occasion and terrific with a platter of fruits de mer. 12.5%. Now-2027

Domaine des Garriguettes, Côtes du Rhône Blanc, Fleur de Lune, France, 2024

Code: GAR624
Bottle: £16.50 6% off 6: £93.06 12% off 12: £174.24

A blend of approximately 50% Clairette, 30% Grenache Blanc and 20% Viognier, with about 20% of the wine rounded in old oak barrels, this is a fresh and vibrant Côtes du Rhône. Fantastic balance of ripe stone fruit and racy, citric acidity. Vital and energetic with true clarity of flavour. 13%. Now-2027



SVS's Finds of 2025

The team have spent time in France, Italy, Spain and South Africa this year, catching up with our growers and seeking out fantastic new wines to bring to SVS customers. These are our top new wines for 2025.

Borgo Paglianetto, Verdicchio di Matelica, Terravignata, Italy, 2024

 **Code: PAG124**

Bottle: £15.95 6% off 6: £89.96 12% off 12: £168.43

Verdicchio di Matelica in the Marche is one of Italy's best kept white wine secrets and Borgo Paglianetto are one of the region's very best growers. Organically farmed from vineyards over 350m above sea level (crucial for preserving fruit and freshness in the wine), this has a seductively open perfume of lime and lemon balm. Crisp citrus on the palate, but some substance too. Excellent all-rounder, as good with light dishes as enjoyed on its own. 12.5%. Now-2027

Ferry Lacombe, Haedus, Côtes de Provence Blanc, France, 2024

 **Code: CFL124**

Bottle: £15.95 6% off 6: £89.96 12% off 12: £168.43

Located in the shadow of the Montagne Sainte-Victoire, made famous by Cézanne's series of post-impressionist paintings, this family-owned domaine make some of our best-selling rosés. This year we were so impressed by one of their white cuveés we just had to ship it. 100% Vermentino with excellent concentration and depth. Zesty lime and flat peach fruit kept in check by a taut mineral backbone. Long and impressive, it will be delicious with seafood. 13%. Now-2026

Domaine Frédéric Lambert, Jura Chardonnay, Les Gryphées, France, 2022

 **Code: LAM322**

Bottle: £26.95 6% off 6: £152.00 12% off 12: £284.59

This is our white wine of the year. It takes its name from the beautiful marine fossils found in the vineyards - and we were delighted when it got a cracking review from Jancis Robinson over the summer. *"Really exciting, energetic wine that smells as though there was a little skin contact and with lots of richness on the palate. Arguably a lot more interesting than many a white burgundy. Definitely recommended and not overpriced. It has a really appetising mineral kick on the end. Seriously interesting and persistent. 17.5/20"* Jancis Robinson MW, [jancisrobinson.com](https://www.jancisrobinson.com), August 2025, 13.5%. Now-2030



La Liquière, Tutti Frutti Rouge, Vin de France, 2024

 **Code: TUT124**

Bottle: £12.95 6% off 6: £73.04 12% off 12: £136.75

We have been shipping La Liquière's wines for many years and were delighted to taste this new project from them back in February. Made from 60% Cinsault, 20% Syrah, and 20% Grenache it is lively and fruity with vibrant blackberry and strawberry fruit. Not our most serious addition to the range this year but definitely one of the most fun. 13%. Now-2026

Villa Tempora, La Demon du Midi, Pézenas, France, 2020

 **Code: TMP320**

Bottle: £23.50 6% off 6: £132.54 12% off 12: £248.16

A big, meaty red that opens up beautifully when decanted and which is perfect for winter. 70% Syrah, 30% Grenache and Mourvèdre. *"You can taste the Syrah right away - meat and leather, dark chocolate and rosemary. Garrigue and earth. It's a swarthy cowboy of a wine that swaggers. Wears its tannins like thigh-high boots and a well-worn saddle. The kind of wine that demands slow-cooked ox cheeks or some kind of game stew. 16.5/20."* Tamlyn Currin, [jancisrobinson.com](https://www.jancisrobinson.com), December 2024. 14.5%. Now-2028

Key to the Wines:  Sparkling  White  Red  Fortified/Sweet  Organic

White Burgundy

White Burgundy remains the reference point for winemakers all around the world – nowhere else can quite match the balance, freshness and depth of flavour that comes from Chardonnay grown on limestone soils in this part of France. A special mention for Lequin-Colin's Back to the Roots Chardonnay – it's a rich, buttery wine that knocks many a village or 1er Cru wine for six.

Domaine Fichet, Mâcon-Burgundy, Les 3 Terroirs, France, 2024

Code: FIC524
Bottle: £16.50 6% off 6: £93.06 12% off 12: £174.24

A fantastic unoaked Chardonnay sourced from three vineyards around the village of Viré. We love this wine for its freshness, consistency and value and have shipped every vintage since 2005. 2024 was a slightly cooler summer than 2023 which adds a slightly fresher dimension to this vintage. White peach and orange blossom on the nose followed by lemon and quince with just a hint of crème fraîche. Deservedly one of our best-selling white Burgundies. 13%. Now-2028

Réné Lequin-Colin, Bourgogne Chardonnay, Back to the Roots, France, 2022

Code: LEQ522
Bottle: £26.95 6% off 6: £152.00 12% off 12: £284.59

"This really does smell and taste much grander than your typical Bourgogne Blanc. Subtle but definite impression of oak in mealy spice and a creamy aspect to the citrus fruit. This has real depth and breadth, the moderate acidity typical of the vintage and sufficient to balance the depth of flavour. Smooth and rich on the palate with a lovely chewy texture and very long finish. You could approach this now but I think it will be even better after another year in bottle. Serious burgundy at a good price. VGV, 16.5/20, 2024-2028", Julia Harding MW, [jancisrobinson.com](https://www.jancisrobinson.com), February 2024. 12.5%. Now-2028

Jean Marie Chaland, Viré-Clessé, L'Epinet, France, 2022

Code: SAB322
Bottle: £28.95 6% off 6: £163.28 12% off 12: £305.71

From a very small plot at the top of the slope, planted in the 1940s on gravel and red clay soils. A third of the wine goes in oldish oak barrels for a year on the lees. The wine is rounded and full, with the telltale concentration of old vines grown on rocky, inhospitable soils, yet also bright and fresh with flavours of wild herbs and citrus. This Pinot Bianco (Blanc) is medium-bodied and concentrated yet limpid. Opens up in the glass with lime, peach and pineapple flavours. Very pure and focused. 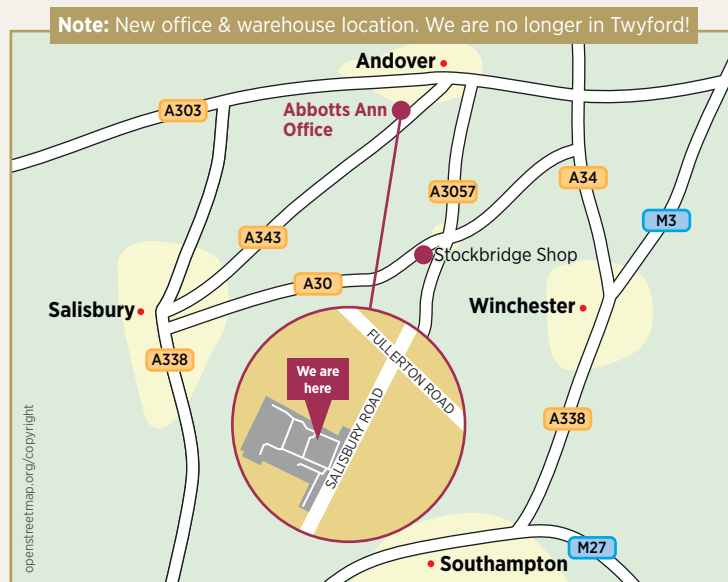
